NOTIFICATION FOR FEE STRUCTURE AND OTHER IMPORTANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSIONS IN ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-25 IN M.D. & M.S. COURSES

1. That **SUBHARTI MEDICAL COLLEGE, MEERUT** is **Buddhist Minority Institution** recognized by National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, New Delhi (letters/orders no. F. No. 1222 of 2015 dated 26.04.2018,).
2. It is also notified that since the State Government was not inclined to accept the certification of the NCMEI, Subharti Medical College filed a Special Leave Petition no 17003 of 2022 at the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India praying to direct the State Government to treat Subharti Medical College as a minority institution.
3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has passed an interim order on 23-04-2024, directing the State Government and the DGME to allot Buddhist students on 50% of seats. The relevant portion is quoted herein below:

“Since the matter is being adjourned at the instance of the State, we are inclined to grant interim protection to the petitioner in terms of prayer clause ‘a’ for the academic session 2024-2025.

4. (i) The college will charge the same fee, Security, hostel & miscellaneous charges from the students of the clinical branches as per the directions of the State Government, till any further order is passed by the Hon. Supreme Court. However, the College will have a different policy for non-clinical subjects, which is mentioned below:-

**Tuition Fee decided by Subharti Medical College for the students of
Non-Clinical Subjects**

(a) Rs. 1,20,000/- per year with Rs. 10,000/- stipend per month.

OR

(b) No Course fee – No stipend

and

a bond to work in the College for at least two Years after passing the final exam with full salary as per the University norms for the post.

5. The student will have to enter into a registered agreement with the College that it will pay the fee as decided by the college (see the fee structure of Teerthankar Mahaveer Medical College, Moradabad for reference), if the Hon'ble Supreme Court passes an order in favor of Subharti Medical College. In such a situation the modified fee will be applicable from the beginning of the course, whenever decided.

Appropriate relaxation in fee will be given to the Buddhist students of weaker economic status so that all deserving Buddhist candidates can get the medical education within their affordable means.

6. **REFUNDABLE SECURITY DEPOSIT:** Rs. 5,00,000/- one time.

7. **HOSTEL:-**

- (i) Hostel is recommended for the P.G. students of all the Clinical Departments.
- (ii) Hostel & Mess charges are as follows:-
 - (a) Rs. 2,50,000/- lacs per year for Non AC single seater accommodation.
 - (b) Rs. 1,75,000/- lacs per year for Non AC double seater accommodation.
 - (c) AC / Air Cooling facility is subject to availability.
 - (d) Hostel charges will increase considering the rise in price index since 2020 as per actual and will further increase each year as per the price index.

8. **MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES:** - Rs. 1,28,400/- per year.

9. **STIPEND OF THE RESIDENT:** - Rs. 30,000/- per month. (Under review)

10. **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- (i) Full Fee and security will be required to be deposited before the LAST DATE declared by the Government / Counseling Board. No Part Payment of Fee is permitted. The student will have to follow existing rules and regulations regarding seat leaving in between the course.
- (ii) Student failed or detained in Final MD/MS examination will have to attend classes & other required training in the concern department without stipend till the supplementary examination. No stipend will be paid during this period. An additional training fee equivalent to 6 months fee will be charged from the students who fail in the final year examination.
- (iii) An additional supplementary exam's fee of Rs. 2 lacs will be charged from failed/detained students.
- (iv) Students admitted under the Buddhist category will have to give an affidavit that the College will be within its rights to verify the certificates submitted by them and also whether they are actually followers of Buddhism or not. If the certificates of Buddhism are found incorrect or the student not found to be a follower of Buddhism, the College will have the right to cancel the admission of such student.
- (v) The students admitted under the Buddhist category will be given appropriate relaxation in the fee on application if the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court comes in favor of the College.
- (vi) The students admitted under the Buddhist category will have to give a Bond that they will work in the institution for a period of two years after passing the final year examination.
- (v) Submission of **Affidavit** for following the working discipline of the Medical College: -

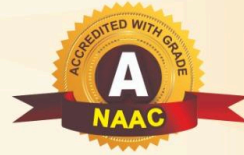
The Medical College reserves the right to take disciplinary action against such P.G. students who do not follow the work discipline and

- Non Clinical Fee - Rs. 8,64,000/- per year (As per UP Govt. Notification)
- Scholarship - 100%*

- Miscellaneous Charge - Nil
- Examination Charges - Rs. 50,000/- per year
