FEE STRUCTURE AND OTHER IMPORTANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION IN ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-25

M.B.B.S. COURSE

All the students aspiring to take admission in MBBS course at Subharti Medical College, Meerut are advised to go through the following regulations very carefully

1. That **SUBHARTI MEDICAL COLLEGE, MEERUT** is **Buddhist Minority Institution** recognized by National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, New Delhi (letters/orders no. F. No. 1222 of 2015 dated 26.04.2018, no. 7-7/2016-NCMEI/4542 dated 13.08.2018).
2. It is also notified that since the State Government was not inclined to accept the certification of the NCMEI, Subharti Medical College filed a Special Leave Petition no 17003 of 2022 at the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India praying to direct the State Government to treat Subharti Medical College as a minority institution.
3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has passed an interim order on 23-04-2024, directing the State Government and the DGME to allot Buddhist students on 50% of seats. The relevant portion is quoted herein below:

"Since the matter is being adjourned at the instance of the State, we are inclined to grant interim protection to the petitioner in terms of prayer clause 'a' for the academic session 2024- 2025.
4. (a) The college will charge the same fee, Security, hostel & miscellaneous charges as mentioned in the notification dated 11.07.2024 of the State Government till any further order is passed by the Hon. Supreme Court.
(b) That in order to pass the benefit given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court to the minority students, the fee shall undergo a change and is likely to be at par with that of other minority Medical Colleges for general students. In such a situation the modified fee will be applicable from the beginning of the course, whenever decided. **You are advised to look into the Fee structure of Era's Medical College Lucknow and Teerthankar Mahaveer Medical College Moradabad, for reference.**
5. The students will have to pay an additional tuition fee @ 1/3 rd of Annual Tuition fee if detained (for whatsoever reason)/failed in each year/session.
6. An additional supplementary exam's fee from failed/detained students will be charged @ Rs. 50,000/- per subject per examination.

7. It will be compulsory for the students to do internship from the College itself. No request for giving NOC for doing internship from any other Hospital for whatsoever reason shall be entertained.
